On June 28, 2021, 42-year-old Daniel Green of Lebanon, Missouri was charged with misdemeanor Property Damage 2nd Degree and Attempted Stealing. Green remains lodged in the Laclede County Jail in lieu of a \$2500 cash or surety bond.

On June 26, 2021, officers responded to the 1100 block of Ivey Lane for a report of stealing in progress. Upon arrival, the reporting party stated she caught Green attempting to cut the catalytic converter off her vehicle. When confronted by the reporting party, Green left the area carrying a dark colored tote bag. Green was located a short time later by officers on Ivey Lane without a tote bag. After a search of the area was conducted, the tote bag was located and after a search of the bag, tools of the crime were located.

Chief Bryan Arnold stated, "Catalytic converter theft continues to be a problem in our community. These thieves do not care about the damage they cause to vehicles or how much it costs hardworking citizens in time and money to correct what they have done. Lebanon police officers will continue to aggressively pursue these criminals and take them to jail every chance we get. Citizens can help by letting us know if you see a suspicious person hanging around your neighborhood or business."

The above charges are mere accusation and are not evidence of guilt. Evidence in support of these charges must be presented before a court of competent jurisdiction whose duty is to determine guilt or innocence.
