FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

On March 1, 2022, Jeremy James Whittle was sentenced to thirteen (13) years in prison by Circuit Court of Miller County, Missouri. Whittle pled guilty to the Class C felonies of Delivery of a Controlled Substance and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm. Specifically, Whittle admitted that he “knowingly possessed methamphetamine” with the intent to distribute a controlled substance. He also pled guilty to unlawfully possessing a firearm which was a crime due to his status as a felon. Whittle was sentenced to ten (10) years in prison for the charge of Delivery of a Controlled Substance and three (3) years in prison for Unlawful Possession of a Firearm. The sentences were ordered served concurrent to each other.

The case was investigated by the Mid-Missouri Drug Task Force. Miller County Prosecuting Ben Winfrey commends Miller County’s law enforcement community for their hard work and dedication.

All defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law. Charges of criminal conduct are not evidence of guilt.
