

June Job Postings 2025-2026 Comparison



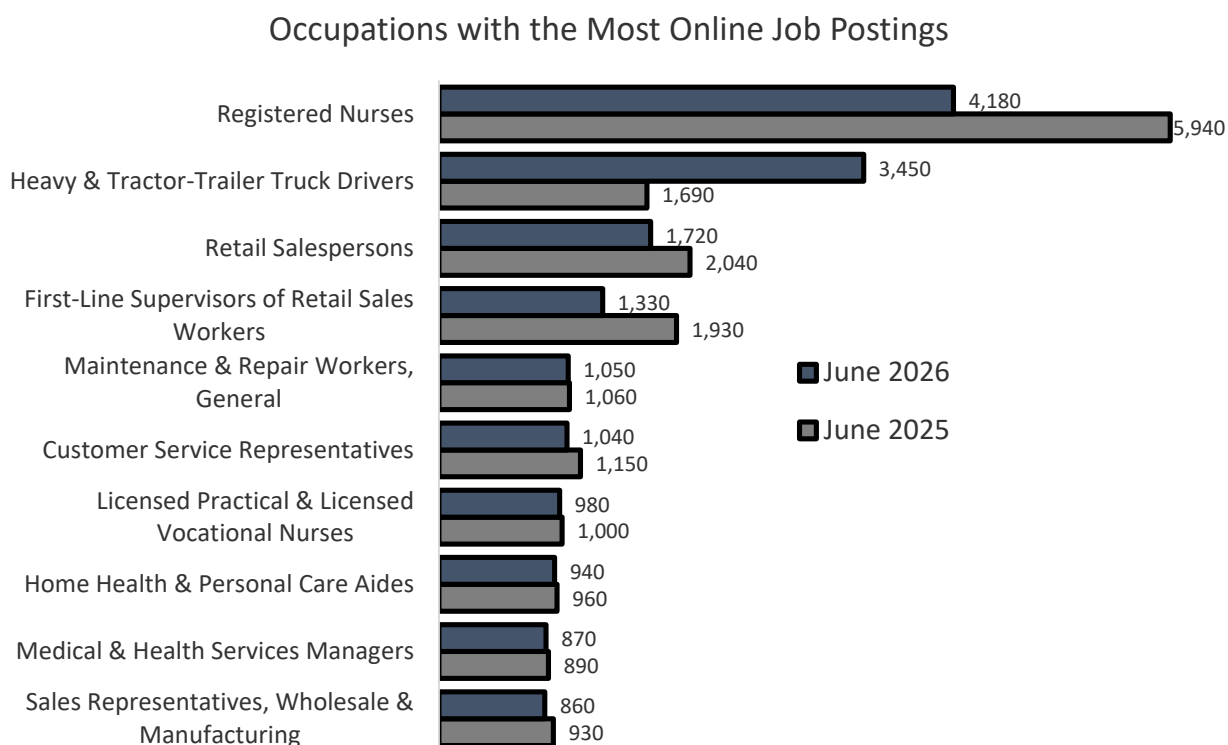
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Job Demand

Job postings decreased 4.7 percent from June 2025 to June 2026. In June 2026, there were 71,490 online job postings compared to 75,000 in June 2025. The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate of 3.7 percent in Missouri was one-tenth of a percentage point lower than in May 2026 and three-tenths of a percentage point lower than in June 2025.

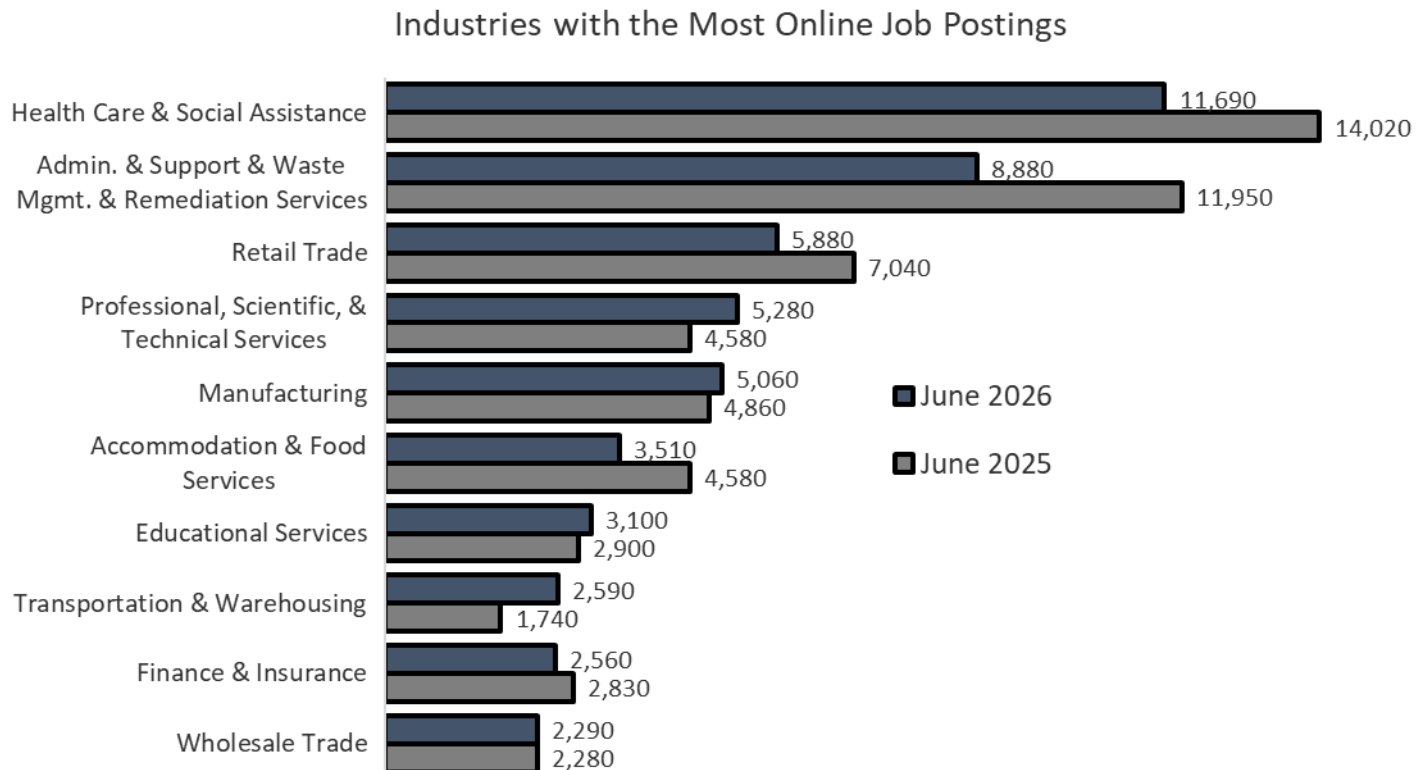
Top Occupations

The following chart shows the top 10 occupations with the most online job postings in June 2026 compared to the number of postings in June 2025. *Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers* had the largest increase (104%), while *First-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers* had the largest decrease (-31%).



Top Industries

The following chart shows the industries with the most online job postings in June 2026 compared to the number of postings in June 2025. *Heavy Truck Drivers* was the occupation that increased the most, while *Transportation and Warehousing* was the industry that had the largest increase (49%). *Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services* had the largest decrease (-26%).
