**SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION
Proposition Together We Rise**

Shall the Board of Education of the Eldon R-I School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the betterment of school facilities including but not limited to: to construct, equip, and furnish additional classrooms at the Middle School; to increase energy efficiency through replacement of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to renovate the Middle School band room; to install new playground equipment; to construct, equip, and furnish an animal laboratory at the High School; to complete other repairs and improvements to existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.5100 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
