Updated Press Release

4-26-21

At approximately 4:15pm on Friday April 23, the Lake Ozark Police Dept. was dispatched to the area of 1140 Bagnell Dam Blvd. (Strip) for reports of shots being fired from a moving vehicle. Calls were also received about the same time of a man in the middle of the street causing problems and threatening passing vehicles. Upon officer's arrival, it was determined both incidents were one in the same. A male subject, eventually identified as Jared Austin Long, DOB: 01/27/1990, 22 Village Marina Rd., Eldon, Missouri, was located and detained as well as a female, later determined to be the victim of a domestic assault. The male subject was combative and physically assaulted officers in the process of taking him into custody. Officers canvased the area and located evidence that shots had been fired. Initial investigation shows that Jared A. Long was riding as a passenger in a vehicle as it traveled east within the 1100 block of Bagnell Dam Blvd., retrieved a handgun from inside the vehicle, and fired 13 shots into the hillside area along the road. During the investigation, officers located a handgun inside the vehicle. No property damage or injuries have been reported. Jared A. Long was transported to Lake Regional Hospital for evaluation and then to the Miller Co. Jail. Long is currently being held on a \$250,000.00 bond for the initial charges of Unlawful Use of a Weapon (B-Felony), Domestic Assault – 3rd Degree (E-Felony), Resisting/Interfering With Arrest for a Felony (E-Felony), Assault – 4th Degree (A-Misdemeanor). Further charges may be pending This investigation is still ongoing. More information may become available at a later time.
