


Scattered Showers and a Few Thunderstorms Today

- The primary hazards of concern at this time are damaging winds, large hail, and flash flooding.





Hazards Expected Thursday – Thursday Night








- The most intense thunderstorms will have the greatest risk of producing damaging wind gusts.
- Large hail will also be possible, especially over southeast Kansas and far western Missouri.
- High rainfall rates could lead to flash flooding.
- Still a few remaining uncertainties to pin down. Continue to monitor the forecast closely.




Excessive Rainfall Outlooks Thursday




• A few locations could receive rainfall amounts over two inches. Rainfall rates are expected to be high at times leading to a risk for flash flooding.
